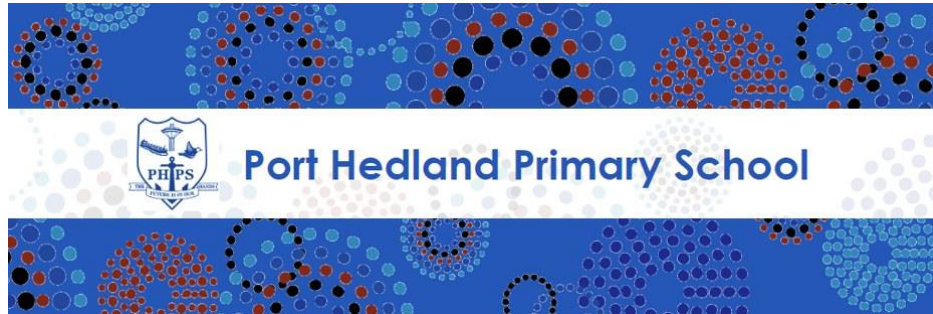

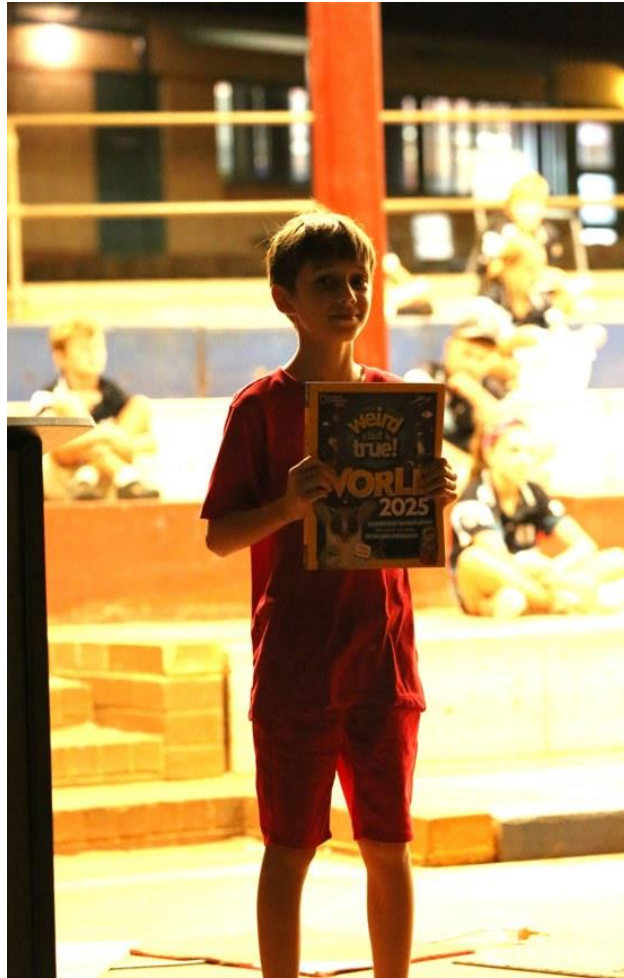

Be aware and keep up to date. ⚠ Schools remain open. ⚠ Students attend as normal. ⚠ Make arrangements if we move to Watch and Act. ⚠ ABC Radio will advise of any updates. Stay informed. ⚠ PLEASE DO NOT RING THE SCHOOL	 WATCH AND ACT There is a possible threat. Take action now to stay safe. If Watch & Act is declared during a school day: ⚠ Before 12pm: - Students to be picked up immediately. - School will close at lunch time (12:30pm). - Bus will be informed of changes. - Students will not be sent home without advice from carers. ⚠ After 12pm: - Students to be picked up immediately. - School will close at the normal time (2:20pm). - Students will not be sent home without advice from carers. ⚠ After 2pm: - School will be closed the following day. - ABC Radio will advise of any updates re: schools re-opening. 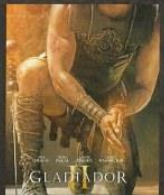
